## \*<u>Hunter</u> classes to be judged predominantly on the horse. \*Equitation classes to be judged predominantly on the rider.

**Leadline** 8 yrs. or younger Classes: 1, 2, 3

To be shown at the walk. Riders must compete with a handler and leadline. May be asked for two-point position. Riders will walk over one ground poll executing the two-point, or "jumping" position. May be asked questions about their horse/pony. Rider may **not** cross enter any other class same day of show. (1A, 2A, 3A para classes offered, judged separately, ridden consecutively)

Walk off the Lead 10yrs. or younger Classes 4, 5, 6

To be shown at the walk. Rider may choose to have an attendant walk with them, or they may compete independently. Coaching by handler prohibited. Rider to perform at the walk. May be asked for two-point position. Riders will walk over one ground poll executing the two-point, or "jumping" position. May be asked questions about their horse/pony. Rider may **not** cross enter any other class same day of show. (4A, 5A, 6A para classes offered, judged separately, ridden consecutively)

Special Walk/Trot Division 10 yrs. or younger Classes 7, 8, 9

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders are **not** expected to know their diagonals. Riders may be asked questions about parts of horse/tack. Riders may be asked for two-point position. Individually, riders will trot over one ground poll executing the two-point, or "jumping" position. Rider may **not** cross enter any other classes same day of show.

Beginner Walk/Trot10 yrs. or youngerClasses 10, 11, 12Beginner Walk/Trot11 - 13 yearsClasses 13, 14, 15Beginner Walk/Trot14 - 17 yearsClasses 16, 17, 18

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders **ARE** expected to know their diagonals. They may be asked questions about parts of horse/tack and may be asked for two-point position. Individually, riders will trot over one 12" cross rail executing the two-point, or "jumping" position. Rider may **not** cross enter any other classes same day of show.

Advanced Walk/Trot10 yrs. or youngerClasses 19, 20, 21 (A ring)Advanced Walk/Trot11-13 yearsClasses 22, 23, 24 (B ring)Advanced Walk/Trot14-17 yearsClasses 25, 26, 27 (B ring)

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders are expected to know diagonals and may be asked for two-point position, sitting trot and/or halt/back. May be asked to change directions at the trot. Over Fences riders will trot a simple course consisting of 4-6 12" crossrail fences, executing the two-point, or "jumping" position.

Limited Canter Division12 yrs. or youngerClasses 29, 30, 31Limited Canter Division13 – 17 yrs.Classes 32, 33, 34

Limited Canter Division 18 & Adult Classes 35, 36, 37 No professionals

Under saddle class will walk and trot as group. Riders will be asked to canter individually (one at a time) in both directions. Over Fences riders may trot or canter fences without penalty. Consistency in gait is rewarded. Simple changes are allowed. Fences to consist of 4 to 6 crossrails fences set at 12". *Rider may cross enter Class 39, 18" Warm Up only.* 

\*Hunter classes to be judged predominantly on the horse.

\*Equitation classes to be judged predominantly on the rider.

Warm Up Classes Limited Canter division - Class 28 18" division - Class 39

2' division – Class 47 2'3 division – Class 55 2'6 division – Class 63

The Warm Up Class is open to riders registered in each division which are held to the division description. This is an over fences class which may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed division height specifications. Riders will **not** be judged, and ribbons will **not** be awarded. Each rider is permitted one trip per entry.

## **Short/Long Stirrup**

**Equitation Div 18"** 17 years or younger Classes: 38, 40, 41,42(Medal class)

**Hunter Div18**" 17 years or younger Classes 43, 44, 45

Flat classes to be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Fence class consists of 6 to 8 verticals no higher than 18". Brush and flower boxes may be used. Simple changes allowed. Division will run as one division unless each section has more than 12 competitors. If division is required to split the separation will be 13 years and younger, and 14-17 years. Medal class will consist of a USEF test and will be noted on the posted jump course. Rider and horse combination not eligible for any other classes or division but Riders may cross enter Class 47, 2' Warm Up only.

## 2' Division

**Equitation** 17 years or younger –NO Professionals Classes: 46,48,49,50(Medal class)

**Low Hunter** Open- Professionals welcome Classes 51, 52, 53

Equitation division is open to junior or amateur riders - no professionals. Flat classes to be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Hunter division is open to all riders- professionals welcome, to be judged on performance and soundness. Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2' in height. Rider and horse combination not eligible for any other classes or division but may cross enter Class 55, 2'3" Warm Up only.

2'3" Children's Equitation 17 or younger Classes: 54, 56, 57, 58 (Medal class)

2'3" Children's Hunter 17 or younger Classes: 59, 60, 61

Open to riders 17 years old and younger. Equitation Flat classes to be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Hunter flat to be judged on performance and soundness Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2' 3 in height. Rider and horse combination not eligible for any other classes or division but Riders may cross enter Class 63, 2'6" Warm Up only.

**2'6" Low Hunter** Open- Professionals welcome Classes 62, 64, 65 Open to riders 17 years old and younger. Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2'6 in height. U/S to be shown at walk, trot, sitting trot and canter both directions. May be asked to execute a change of direction at the trot. Rider and horse combination not eligible for any other classes or division.
