- Equitation classes to be judged on the rider
- Hunter classes to be judged on the horse
- Classes may be split depending on the number of entries at the show manager's discretion.
- Cross entries for classes 1-30 will be permitted for riders entering multiple horses. However, entries must be in comparable divisions. For more info, please contact JHAhorsemens@gmail.com before submitting your entry.

#### Leadline (8 & U)

Classes: 1, 2, 3

To be shown at the walk. Riders must compete with a handler and leadline. May be asked to show a two-point position. Riders to walk over one ground pole in two-point, or "jumping" position. May be asked questions about their horse/pony. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show. (1A, 2A, 3A para classes offered, judged separately, ridden concurrently)

#### Walk off the Lead (10 & U)

Classes 4, 5, 6

To be shown at the walk. Rider may have an attendant walk with them, or they may compete independently. Coaching by handler prohibited. May be asked to show a two-point position. Riders to walk over one ground pole in two-point, or "jumping" position. May be asked questions about their horse/pony. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show. (4A, 5A, 6A para classes offered, judged separately, ridden concurrently)

# Intro Walk/Trot (10 & U) No Diagonals Classes 7, 8, 9

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders are <u>not</u> expected to know their diagonals. Riders may be asked questions about parts of horse/tack. Riders may be asked to show a two-point position. Individually, riders to trot over one ground pole in two-point, or "jumping" position. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

Beginner Walk/Trot (10 & U) Classes 10, 11, 12
Beginner Walk/Trot (11-17) Classes 13, 14, 15
Beginner Walk/Trot (Adult) No Professionals Classes 16, 17, 18

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders must know their diagonals. They may be asked questions about parts of horse/tack and may be asked to show a two-point, or jumping position. Individually, riders will trot over one 12" cross rail in two-point, or "jumping" position. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

#### Walk/Trot Crossrails (17 & U) Classes 19, 20, 21

To be shown at the walk and trot. Riders are expected to know diagonals and may be asked for two-point position, sitting trot and/or halt/back. May be asked to change directions at the trot. Over Fences riders will trot a simple course consisting of 4 12" crossrail fences, using two-point, or "jumping" position over crossrails. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

# Individual Canter (13 & U) Classes 22, 23, 24 Individual Canter (Open) No professionals Classes 25, 26, 27

To be shown at the walk and trot as a group. Riders will be asked to canter individually (one at a time) in both directions. Over Fences riders may trot or canter a simple course of 4 12" crossrails. Consistency in gait is rewarded. Simple changes are allowed. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

### Canter Crossrails (17 & U)

Classes 28, 29, 30

To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Over fence classes to be shown at the canter, simple changes allowed. Over fence classes consist of 6-8 12" crossrails. Rider/Horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

#### Warm Up Class O/F

Classes 32, 39, 46, 53

Warm Up Class is open to riders registered in each division which are held to the division description (Both Equitation & Hunter). To be shown over fences, consisting of 6-8 fences not to exceed division height specifications. **Riders are judged and ribbons awarded**. Each rider is permitted one trip per entry.

# Short/Long Stirrup (17 & U)

Equitation

Classes 31, 33 & 34 Medal class

Hunter

Classes 35, 36, 37

To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Over fence classes consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 18" and may include brush/flower boxes. Simple changes allowed. Medal class will consist of a USEF test and will be posted. Rider/Horse combination eligible to enter **both** 18" divisions, but may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

#### 2' Equitation (17 & U)

Classes 38, 40 & 41 Medal class

To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Over fence classes consist of 6-8 fences, not to exceed 2' and may include brush/flower boxes. Medal class will consist of a USEF test and will be posted. Rider/Horse combination eligible to enter **both** 2' divisions, but may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

#### 2' Low Hunter (open)

Classes 42, 43, 44

Open to junior, amateur, & professional riders. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Judged on the horse's performance, manners, soundness and way of going. Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2' and may include brush/flower boxes. Rider/Horse combination eligible to enter **both** 2' divisions, but may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

2'3" Children's Equitation (17 & U) Classes 45, 47, 48 Medal class

2'3" Children's Hunter (17 & U) Classes 49, 50, 51

To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot, halt, back, and/or reverse at the trot. Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2' 3 and may include brush/flower boxes. Medal class will consist of a USEF test and will be posted. Rider/Horse combination eligible to enter **both** 2'3" divisions, but may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.

## **2'6" low Hunter (Open)** Classes:52, 54, 55

Open to junior, amateur, and professional riders. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter. Judged on the horse's performance, manners, soundness and way of going. Over fences may consist of 6-8 fences not to exceed 2'6 and may include brush/flower boxes. Rider/horse combination may **not** cross enter any other classes day of show.
